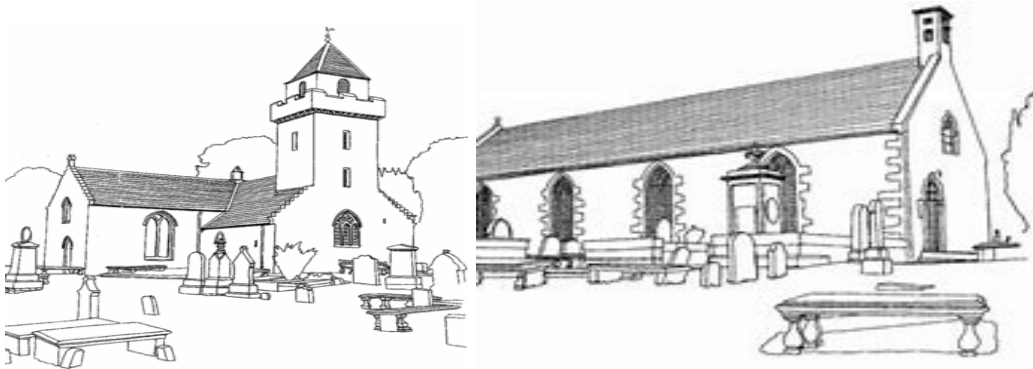

Jesus Came to Give **Eternal Life**.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16) Now this is the greatest Christmas gift one can receive - the gift of eternal life. Jesus came to give eternal life to whoever believes in Jesus.

It's a sad day when people are offered the kingdom of heaven, but they don't see its value. They set it aside as a common thing and go their way. Imagine going to an antique store and finding a priceless antique there. The seller has priced it as a common item. But it is worth many times more than the price being asked. It could be bought for pennies, but like many others you passed it up. You thought it was as common as the other articles in the store. A few days later you read in the local news that someone has bought that item at the antique store. He paid the rock bottom price being asked. But unlike you, he perceived its value to be much greater than the asking price. He had it appraised by experts and learned it is worth millions of pounds. You look at the picture of that item in the news article. It is the one you picked up and examined a few days earlier. It was in your hand. It could have been yours. But you passed it up. If only you had perceived the true value of that treasure. You could have bought it and become rich. How many people have heard the gospel of Christ but passed it up?

In our short parable today, Matthew 13:44-46 . Jesus said, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field."

Jesus Teaches Nicodemus

You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."^[d] ⁹ "How can this be?" Nicodemus asked. ¹⁰ "You are Israel's teacher," said Jesus, "and do you not understand these things? ¹¹ Very truly I tell you, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. ¹² I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things? ¹³ No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the Son of Man.^[e] ¹⁴ Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up,^[f] ¹⁵ that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him."^[g]¹⁶ For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

Reflection



Be not afraid, I am with you, come follow me, I will give you peace and I will bring you home, I love you and you are mine- the words of Jesus

When the holy child was born in a rustic setting near the shepherds' fields in Bethlehem, few knew that heaven's greatest gift had come down to the earth. Mary wrapped "the gift" in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger. Approximately 33 years later, Roman soldiers rudely and cruelly unwrapped "the gift," stripping Him of His clothing and subjecting the Son of God to humiliation and torture. But it was all the unfolding of a plan: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

The Everlasting Father gave the best He had. He gave His only Son. He gave precious, sinless blood. No greater love could have been expressed. No greater sacrifice could have been made. No greater gift could have been given. But the generosity of heaven had only just begun.

At Christmas we sing the well-known carol, "Joy to the world, the Lord has come." When we hear this carol at Christmas, we can ask ourselves what the real reason for this season and what would we be saying, yes of course you'd all shout out, it's about Jesus. Of course, for we all know this, and I don't need to tell you...It's not about bright lights, or decorated trees, or finding the perfect gift. It's about Jesus, well I suppose it is about the most important gift we could ever receive, that gift which we received from God. But what is it about Jesus? How *exactly* is Jesus the reason for Christmas? The answer to this question lies in the reasons *why* Jesus came to this world.

Shall we allow Jesus to speak to us today?

I Came to Give MY Life as a Ransom for Many - "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:45)

I Came to Call Sinners to Repentance - Jesus answered them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance." (Luke 5:31-32)

I Came to Give you Eternal Life - "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

And yes, for sure he did, but you know, he came also to teach the world how to live a life which is not selfish or about oneself...a life where people are offered

the hand of fellowship without expecting payment, or having to do something in return. Someone said to me not that long ago, you know Robert, there aren't many people out there who will do something for nothing...whether this is true or not. I think we have seen people do many wonderful things not expecting payment, while I have seen people not lift a hand without money being handed over first. As we went into lockdown, I received a knock at my door...I am going to Nairn, can I get you anything, and as I lay in bed with shingles a few months earlier, I received telephone calls and text messages from certain people asking me, what do you need, even one person said after I said thank you but I need nothing, not even a doughnut someone enquired, let me get you a jam doughnut....how did they know I love them. Not even the thought of a sugary dough ring could make me change my mind. People do help in times of need for we have seen this during the pandemic, people phoning, knocking on doors, looking out for each other. Streets, towns, cities even in country villages people who have never spoken, neighbours have started talking to each other, friendships have been made, and time shared as we all faced the uncertainty...now we are going back to what was. Possibly the phone calling has become less often, the emails and the knocks at the doors have become less frequent or stopped, yet there is still a need for help. Maybe even more so now, for many of us are finding it hard to get our head around what is happening today, is it safe to go out? aren't the covid numbers rising yet life seems to be relaxing, going back to a place which is familiar...while for some leaving the home has become scary for lock down may have become a safety blanket for some, while others were climbing the walls. Today there is still a need, for human contact having the feeling of not being on our own, receiving the hand of fellowship.

Story - Mary Lundie was born at Kelso in the heart of the sheep -rearing district. As she walked over the border hills in the early summer, she loved to watch the lambs at play. These little creatures are so helpless that the shepherd has to watch them carefully by day and by night. In due course Mary got married and became Mary Duncan and had two children. But when she was still only 25, she became seriously ill that she knew her little ones would soon be left motherless. And they, too, like the little lambs, were amusing and innocent and helpless in a big world full of danger. And so, for them and for all the helpless children in the world, Mary wrote the beautiful hymn *Jesus, tender Shepherd, hear me*. "*Jesus, tender Shepherd, hear me, bless your little lamb tonight, through the darkness please be near me, watch my sheep till morning light. All this day your hand has led me, and I thank you for your care. You have clothed me, warmed and fed me, listen to my evening prayer*". Ah what lovely words which can be a source of comfort and strength.

When Nicodemus came to Jesus, he said to Him, that no one could help be impressed with the signs and the wonders that Jesus did. Jesus said it was not the signs and wonders that were really important the important thing was such a change in a person's inner life that it could only be described as a new birth. When Jesus said that a man must be born again, Nicodemus misunderstood Him, and the misunderstanding came from the fact that the word came with three different meanings. It can mean from the beginning, completely and radically, or it can mean again, in the sense of, for the second time and finally, it can mean from above, and therefore from God. Today's sermon is not about rebirth in the Nicodemus sense, it's about people and how we can help folk in need. It is actually about rebirth, helping people as they come out of the Pandemic fear, giving a hand of fellowship to someone who wishes to leave the old and begin the new...being at the end of the phone and showing kindness and a caring nature. Being like Christ. I have started to ask people to help begin a hand of fellowship group where we collect names and with the persons permission have someone phone or call each week or fortnightly. It is very much the hand of fellowship. The acceptance of I am here for you let me help. Its having a blether about life in general, how are you doing without any motives. Often when a group is formed within the church people outside will say what do you want and that we are trying to drum up trade, or after money. I believe that the church should be going to the community and saying what can we do for you, not what they can do for us.

Story- Every Saturday morning you could see a woman come along hand in hand with a little girl. When they reached a certain flower shop the woman gently guided the child through the door. I Say, "guide," for the little girl was blind and almost deaf. The shop assistant brings her posies of whatever is in season. The girl touches each flower ever so gently, then bends over and breathes deep of its fragrance. Finally, she makes her choice, the woman pays and with a pleasant "Good morning" the little weekly ceremony is ended. Now do you see why this woman is honoured? She knows the girl can neither see nor hear the beautiful things of nature. But she has discovered that from the mere touch and perfume of flowers the girl draws the greatest pleasure. That's why the author of this tale Francis gay from the friendship book knows this woman who celebrates Christmas each week. Wouldn't it be wonderful if we could do the same for someone in need...offering the hand of fellowship and celebrate Christmas every week.

Today is about thinking what I can do for someone and not ask for anything back. Could we read a story to someone who finds it difficult to see or read, to sit and listen to tales, and ask how someone is doing. Can we share an hour or two of our time to be a friend and offer our hand of fellowship? If you know of

someone who could do with a friend let's not simply know about them, can we act upon it. I would be happy to be given names so we can begin looking after our community. The church, it's not a historical building or a community building, the church is not a tent in the middle of the garden or a new modern building in the middle of town. The Church are those of us who come to worship each week, and receive something that at times we cannot describe and put into words...yet we receive the gift, the greatest of them all, the gift of life.

Let me leave you with the words from the song from the Hollies "He ain't Heavy, He's My Brother," "The road is long, with a many a winding turn, that leads us to who knows where who knows where but I'm strong, strong enough to carry him, o yeah, He ain't heavy, he's my brother so on we go, his welfare is of my concern, no burden is he to bear we'll get there for I know, he would not encumber me He ain't heavy, he's my brother, If I'm laden at all I'm laden with sadness that everyone's heart Isn't filled with the gladness Of love for one another It's a long, long road from which there is no return while we're on the way to there, why not share and the load doesn't weigh me down at all. He ain't heavy, he's, my brother. He's, my brother.

Story- You can't help growing old. You can't help becoming frail. You can't help becoming lonely if your loved ones die. If you who read these words are not old yet, if you're not frail yet, if you're not lonely yet, how thankful you should be. And, having health and strength and friends, what a lovely thing if you would befriend just one person, man or woman, -somebody you could visit for half an hour, say once a week, whose library book you could change, whose letters you might post. How that old body or the one young at heart would listen for your steps! Perhaps you can't do it, but if you can, I am sure your own life will be all the richer...Francis gay 1953.

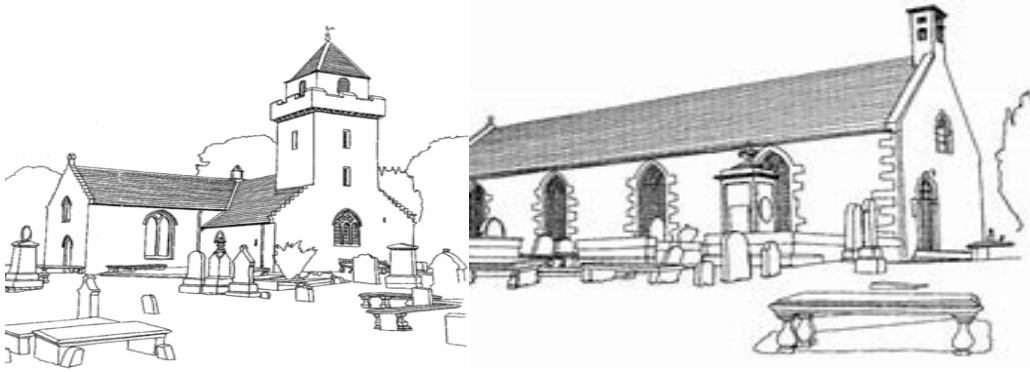
